

These ten designs are to be sewn using two layers of water-soluble stabilizer and a double layer of “sparkle Tulle”. They are sewn in a 4 x 4 inch embroidery hoop. Standard applique technique is used. The first set of stitches creates the placement stitches, the second set of stitches tacks down the applique, and after the second set of stitches is sewn, remove from machine and cut away excess material from around the star. Return hoop to machine and sew the remaining stitches, which create the lace base and the star design. Remove stabilizer by placing completed star in warm water. Press between paper towels to remove most of the water. Let dry flat.

Designs can also be sewn on just the two layers of stabilizer as stand-alone lace.
