

Instructions: FSL-Mylar-Winter-Mix-5x7 Designs





## Required materials:

- Water-soluble stabilizer
- Mylar-desired colors for designs
- Threads as indicated in Color Sequence Charts

It is important to use the same color bobbin thread as the needle thread color so the design will be reversible. Colors for the snowman and snowman outline are the same as the stitches used to tack down the Mylar. A different color was used to force the machine to stop during the stitching process at appropriate times.

### ATWNLS1252-5x7 (Snowman with Snowball)

#### Color Sequence:



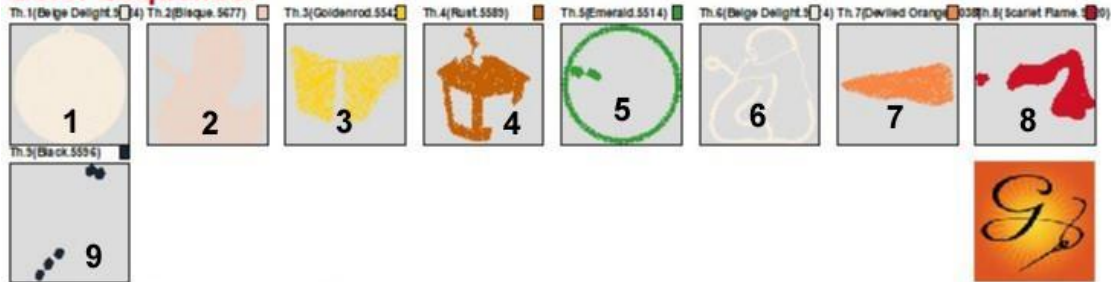
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1. Hoop one layer of water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch hoop.
2. Sew #1 in Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the lace base of the design.
3. Remove hoop from machine and place Mylar over the lace base on both front and back of hoop. Tape in place.
4. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the Mylar to the lace base.
5. Remove hoop from machine and tear away the Mylar from both front and back of hoop.
6. Return hoop to machine and sew #3-6 in the Color Sequence Chart. Stitching the design is complete.
7. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
8. Cut away stabilizer from around the design. Leave about ¼ to ½ inch of stabilizer around design to prevent cutting design stitches.
9. Place in water to remove excess stabilizer. Blot design on paper towels to remove most of the water.
10. Place the design between clean, white, fabric and place a book on top of the design to help it dry flat.
11. When dry, project is ready to use or give as a special gift.

## ATWNLS1253-5x7 (Snowman with lantern)

### Color Sequence:



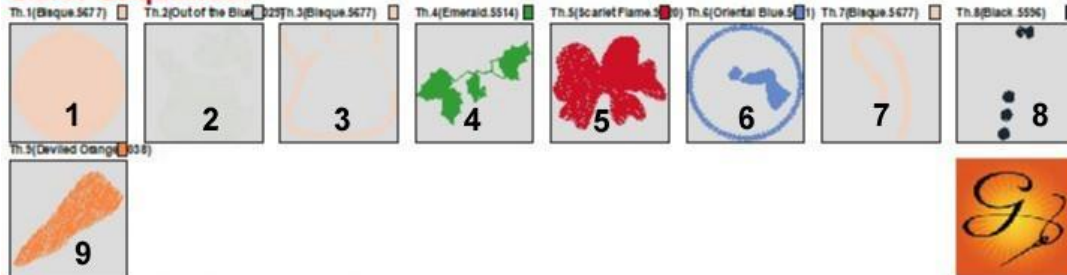
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1. Hoop one layer of water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch hoop.
2. Sew #1 in Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the lace base of the design.
3. Remove hoop from machine and place Mylar over the lace base on both front and back of hoop. Tape in place.
4. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the Mylar to the lace base.
5. Remove hoop from machine and tear away the Mylar from both front and back of hoop.
6. Return hoop to machine and sew #3-9 in the Color Sequence Chart. Stitching the design is complete.
7. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
8. Cut away stabilizer from around the design. Leave about ¼ to ½ inch of stabilizer around design to prevent cutting design stitches.
9. Place in water to remove excess stabilizer. Blot design on paper towels to remove most of the water.
10. Place the design between clean, white, fabric and place a book on top of the design to help it dry flat.
11. When dry, project is ready to use or give as a special gift.

## ATWNLS1254-5x7 (Snowman with Holly)

### Color Sequence:



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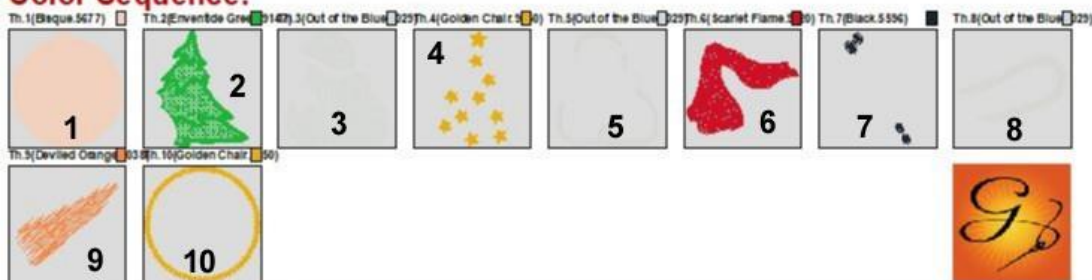


1. Hoop one layer of water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch hoop.
2. Sew #1 in Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the lace base of the design.

- Remove hoop from machine and place Mylar over the lace base on both front and back of hoop. Tape in place.
- Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the Mylar to the lace base.
- Remove hoop from machine and tear away the Mylar from both front and back of hoop.
- Return hoop to machine and sew #3-9 in the Color Sequence Chart. Stitching the design is complete.
- Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
- Cut away stabilizer from around the design. Leave about ¼ to ½ inch of stabilizer around design to prevent cutting design stitches.
- Place in water to remove excess stabilizer. Blot design on paper towels to remove most of the water.
- Place the design between clean, white, fabric and place a book on top of the design to help it dry flat.
- When dry, project is ready to use or give as a special gift.

### ATWNLS1255-5x7 (Snowman with Christmas tree)

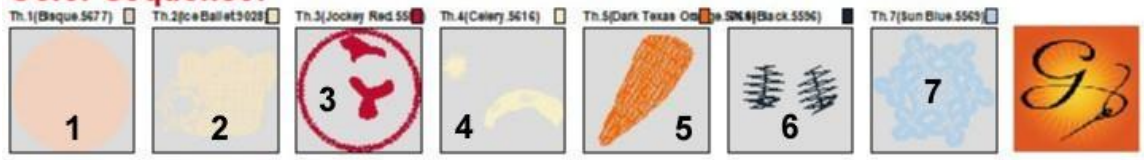
#### Color Sequence:



- Hoop one layer of water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch hoop.
- Sew #1 in Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the lace base of the design.
- Remove hoop from machine and place Mylar *for the tree* over the lace base on both front and back of hoop. Tape in place.
- Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the Mylar over the tree to the lace base.
- Remove hoop from machine and tear away the Mylar from both front and back of hoop.
- Place Mylar for the Snowman over the front and back of the lace base.
- Return hoop to machine and sew # 3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the Mylar over the snowman area to the lace base.
- Remove hoop from machine and tear away the Mylar from both front and back of hoop.
- Return hoop to machine and sew #4-10 in the Color Sequence Chart. Stitching the design is complete.
- Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
- Cut away stabilizer from around the design. Leave about ¼ to ½ inch of stabilizer around design to prevent cutting design stitches.
- Place in water to remove excess stabilizer. Blot design on paper towels to remove most of the water.
- Place the design between clean, white, fabric and place a book on top of the design to help it dry flat.
- When dry, project is ready to use or give as a special gift.

## ATWNLS1256-5x7 (Snowman with Snowflake)

### Color Sequence:



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1. Hoop one layer of water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch hoop.
2. Sew #1 in Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the lace base of the design.
3. Remove hoop from machine and place Mylar for snowman over the lace base on both front and back of hoop. Tape in place.
4. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the Mylar to the lace base.
5. Remove hoop from machine and tear away the Mylar from both front and back of hoop.
6. Return hoop to machine and sew #3-6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create all of the design, except the snowflake.
7. Remove hoop from machine and place Mylar for snowflake over the front and back of the lace base and tape in place.
8. Return hoop to machine and sew #7 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the snowflake Mylar to the lace base.
9. Remove hoop from machine and tear away the Mylar from around the snowflake
10. Remove project from hoop.
11. Cut away stabilizer from around the design. Leave about ¼ to ½ inch of stabilizer around design to prevent cutting design stitches.
12. Place in water to remove excess stabilizer. Blot design on paper towels to remove most of the water.
13. Place the design between clean, white, fabric and place a book on top of the design to help it dry flat.
14. When dry, project is ready to use or give as a special gift.
