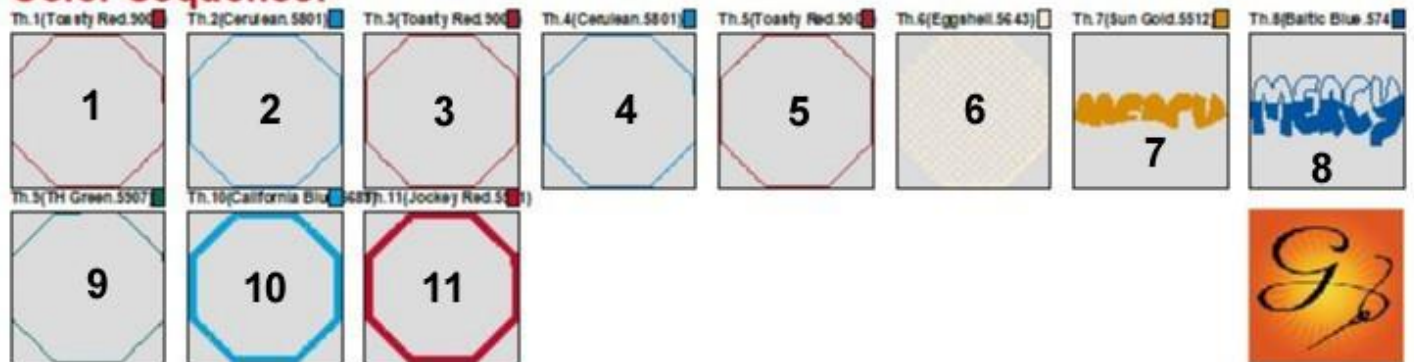
Materials/Cutting Chart

Materials	Number of Cuts	Size of cuts
Fabric for Front & Back	2 cuts	6 x 6 inches
Fabric for Center	1 cut	5 x 5 inches
Puffy Foam (3mm thick)	1 cut	6 x 6 inches
Heat-N-Bond Lite	3 cuts	2 cuts at 6 x 6 inches 1 cut at 5 x 5 inches
Water Soluble Stabilizer	Enough for a 5 x 7 embroider hoop	
Threads	Colors of choice (for these designs, colors used are really just used to stop the machine.)	



The Color Sequence Chart below will be referenced throughout these instructions.

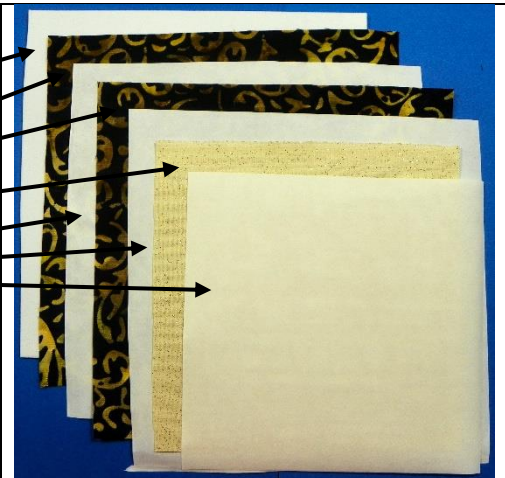
Color Sequence:



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1. Prepare materials as indicated in the Materials/Cutting Chart.

Puffy Foam
Fabric-Front & Back
Fabric-Center
Heat-N-Bond Lite



2. Press the Heat-N-Bond Lite to the backs of the fabric pieces. You should now have the following:

Fabric with Heat-N-Bond fused to back

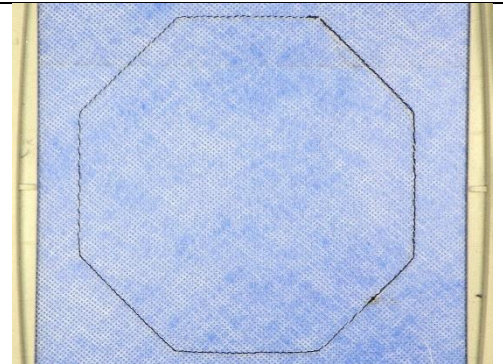
Puffy Foam



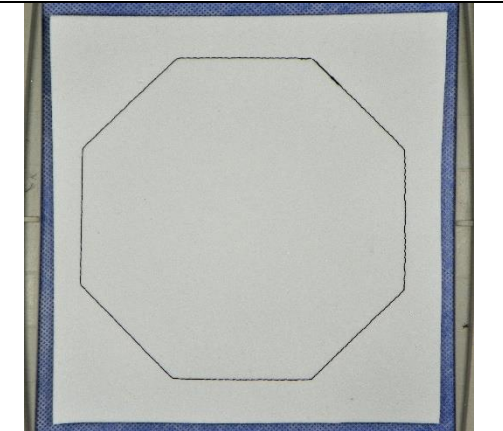
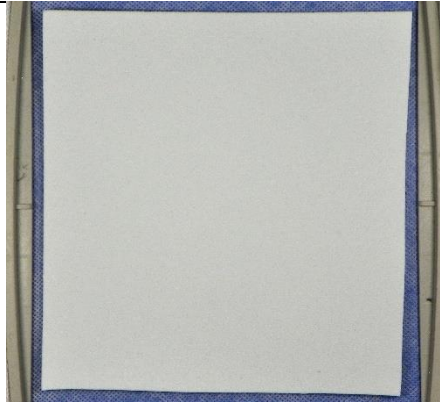
3. Hoop the water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch hoop and attach to machine.
4. Transfer design to embroidery machine.



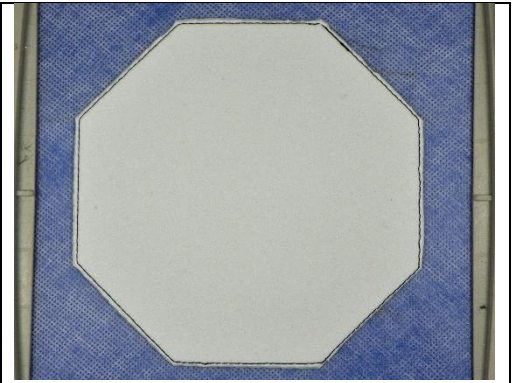
5. Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches for the project.



6. Place the foam piece over the placement stitches and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the foam to the stabilizer.



7. Remove hoop from machine and carefully cut away excess foam from around the project.



8. Remove the paper backing from one of the 6 x 6 inch fabric pieces and place it over the foam. Secure with pins or tape.



9. Return hoop to machine and sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the fabric to the foam and stabilizer.



10. Sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create placement stitches for the fabric center.



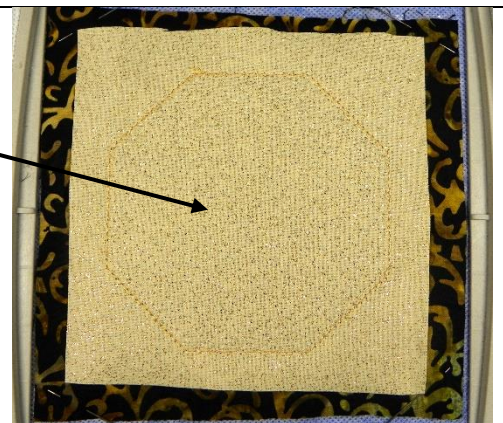
11. Remove hoop from machine, remove paper backing from fabric for center, and place the fabric over the placement stitches. Secure with tape.



12. Return hoop to machine and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the center fabric to the rest of the project.



13. Sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the "quilting" for the center of the project.



14. Sew #7 and #8 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the top and bottom text and the outline around the text.



15. Remove hoop from machine and carefully cut away the excess center fabric.



16. Turn the hoop upside-down on a flat surface. Remove the paper backing from the last fabric piece (6 x 6 inches) and place it over the back of the project. Secure with tape.



17. Return hoop to machine and sew #9 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the back fabric to the project.



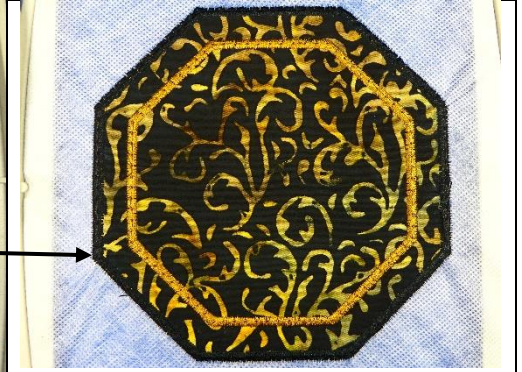
18. Sew #10 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin border and top stitching around the center of the project.



19. Remove hoop from machine and carefully cut away excess fabric from around the front and back of the hoop.



20. Return hoop to machine and sew #11 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin border and top stitching around the outside of the project.



21. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop. Cut away almost all of the stabilizer-leave a little stabilizer to prevent cutting the border.



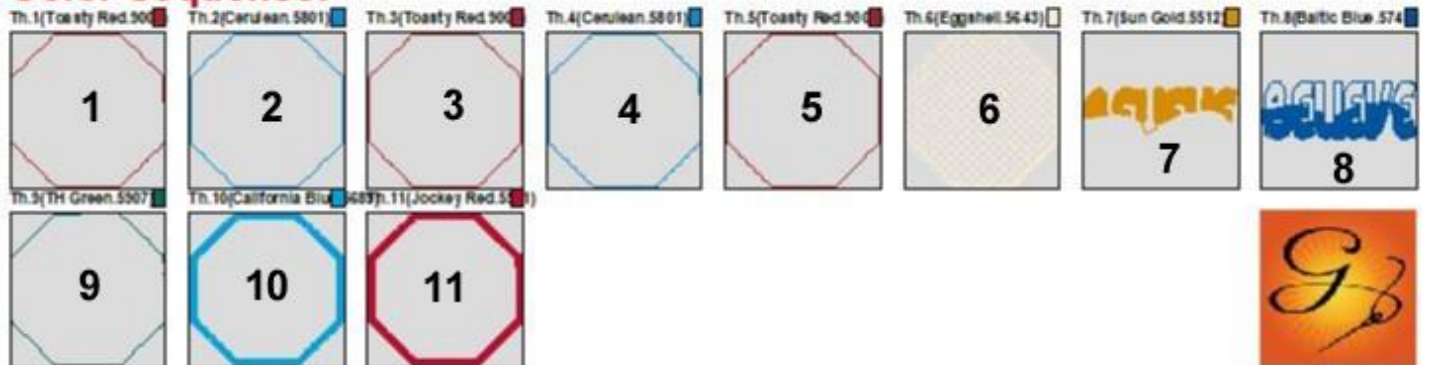
22. Use a wet paper towel, Q-Tip, or cloth to remove the remaining stabilizer from around the project.
23. Let dry and your project is finished.



The other nine designs in this set can be sewn following the previous instructions. The only difference will be the "word" used on the project. I have included the Color Sequence Charts for the other nine designs for your convenience.

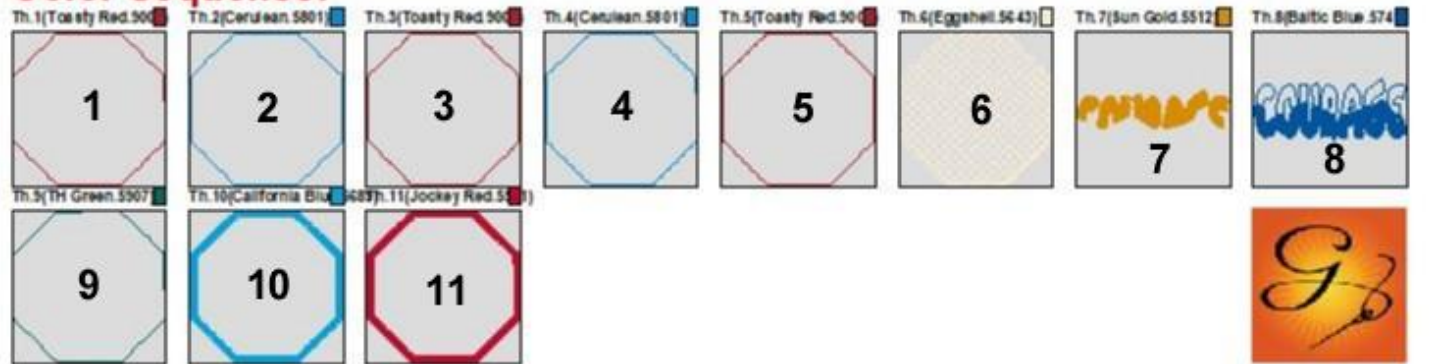
