

Please read through directions prior to beginning your project.

I want to do an applique, where do I start?

- 1) Select your pattern or design.
- 2) Decide where you'd like to put the design; pants, shirt, skirt ect.
- 3) Choose the fabric you'll be using to create your applique.
- 4) Apply Heat N Bond Lite to the BACK of your applique fabric, removing paper back
- 5) Load design into your embroidery machine and begin stitching.

Red and blue are recognized in the embroidery industry as your placement and tack down lines. It is not meant for you to put red then blue in your machine for stitching. The color change makes your machine stop.

- 6) Hollyhock red is used to show your PLACEMENT line for your fabric.
- 7) Lay an ample piece of fabric completely covering your placement line.
- 8) Blue is used to show your TACKDOWN line. Proceed and stitch the blue tackdown line.
- 9) Remove hoop from machine and carefully trim away excess fabric. Get as close to the tackdown line as you can.
- 10) Use a small craft iron to carefully press the applique fabric while still in the hoop. The Heat N Bond Lite will keep your applique looking crisp through many washings.
- 11) Return your hoop to your machine and proceed, working your way through your design.
