

## ATW-Peekers Snowmen-Diane Dillon

Please read through directions prior to beginning your project.

- 1) Select your pattern or design.
- 2) Decide where you'd like to put the design; pants, shirt, skirt ect.
- 3) Mylar will be used in conjunction with embroidery.
- 4). Hoop your fabric. Cut a 4"x4" piece of mylar and center in your embroidery hoop. Use small pieces of tape at corners to hold mylar in place, if you'd like. Secure hoop in your machine.
- 5). Load design into your embroidery machine and begin stitching working your way through all colors. The first color is a basting stitch to hold your mylar in place.
- 6). Remove hoop from machine and carefully tear excess mylar away. Use tweezers if necessary to remove small pieces stuck in corners.

Mylar will melt! Be careful when using your iron.
